STYLES

OIL

Classic Oil, sometimes also called "Rembrandt" is a realistic portrait style with saturated deep colors and usually overall darker shades. Elaborately painted details, barely visible brush strokes, slightly austere posing. It will fit classic interior with darker furniture and antique decoration.

Modern Oil - Free style painting with rough and wide strokes. Colors are bright and saturated, impasto effect is often used for more expression. Absence of small detail - it's about overall emotional atmosphere rather than realism. A good choice for a modern apartment interior with bright contrasting colors and furniture of a simple laconic design.



WATERCOLOR

**Light, "pastel" colors. Light, slightly blurred painting.
Overall relaxed and gracefully indolent mood.**

**It's a good match for a house with lot of light, light furniture,
elegant interior with elements of cut glass, lace, flower ornament.**

Works well with shabby chick, white cottage, colonial and waterfront styles



SEPIA & MONOCHROME

"Sepia tone" is a special effect to give your portrait a warm, old fashioned look. Black and White is used to stress the texture of a subject and/or light and shadow pattern. Both styles are spectacular in combination with a few colored elements. Properly framed a portrait like this will enrich any interior.
